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No permit means what you are doing breaks federal law and 10 years in prison. 33 U.S.C. §1251 et seq. (1972) Clean water act. The Oregon DEQ 401 is only about turbidity. It also says you must have a Clean Water Section permit. You must put everything back to the way it was at this dam and leave. Your permit was withdrawn March 12th 2024. The DEQ 401 permit is just about turbidity maximums. Its still says you need a section 404 permit which you don't have. Below is our Section 404 permit and Joint application applied for in January for salmonprotectiondevice.com. You must cease and desist and put the dam back as it was. Otherwise this will be an easy complaint to file in Medford Federal Court Monday and ask for adjudication of defendants to the Federal prosecutor for federal law violations. 
